2018, 2500HD, Silverado, 4WD, 6.0 Engine, Reg Bed, Extended Cab I've been a loyal Chevy owner for a long time. Have purchased 4 or 5 new Chevy pickups since the early 80's. A little more research shows that the 6.0L had both, small block and big block configuration to it. It was a big block from the 60's until the mid 90's and was used in trucks and school buses. The LS based small-block engine is the primary V-8 used in General Motors' line of rear-wheel-drive cars and trucks. Introduced in January 1995, it is a "clean sheet" design with only rod bearings, lifters, and bore spacing in common with the longstanding Chevrolet small block V8 that preceded it as the basis for GM small-block V8s. The basic LS variations use cast iron blocks, while ...409. A 409 cu in (6.7 L) version was Chevrolet's top regular production engine from 1961 to 1965, with a choice of single or 2X4-barrel Rochester carburetors. Bore x stroke were both up from the 348 cu in (5.7 L) to 4.31 in x 3.12 in (109.5 mm x 88.9 mm). On December 17, 1960, the 409 engine was announced along with the Impala SS (Super Sport) model.
