

Download Algebra 1 Hands On Group Activities

Students play a generalized version of connect four, gaining the chance to place a piece on the board by solving an algebraic equation. Parameters: Level of difficulty of equations to solve and type of problem. My Algebra 1 students just finished up their first unit on Thursday. This year, I am attempting to model my Algebra 1 class on the Kagan Cooperative Learning Algebra 1 curriculum. As I'm getting to know my students, I have made some adjustments. Before beginning the experiment, you are expected to develop a hypothesis based on what you have learned in this unit. Using your knowledge of the types and number of bonds found in sugars, fats, and carbohydrates, make a prediction as to which food group has the highest and lowest calorie content. You may refer to food labels or conduct an internet search.
